VOLUNTEER COMMITTEE DESCRIPTIONS

The following are brief descriptions of the volunteer committees available for the tournament. Specific openings are not guaranteed, but the tournament will make every effort to accommodate your preferences. Please take a moment to review the following requirements before making your final committee selection.

Age Requirements: Volunteers must be at least 18 years of age as of the first day of tournament week, unless a legal guardian signs the volunteer application/waiver. Volunteers 13 and under **MUST** volunteer with a parent or guardian.

Shifts Required: In general, volunteers are asked to complete a minimum of three (4-6 hour) shifts in order to participate as a volunteer. Most committees will have an a.m. and p.m. shift. **HOWEVER**, some committees are not asked to report until later in the day due to the tournament needs.

COMMITTEES

Admissions/Will Call: Responsible for staffing the ticket booth and assisting security to ensure that all spectators have the proper tickets for entry; responsible for staffing a location for ticket buyers to pick up previously purchased tickets

Caddie Tent: Distribute and gather caddie bibs and towels, register professionals' caddies and manage caddie tent

Carts & Shuttles: Manage the cart area and control the charging, distribution, and collection of carts to authorize personnel. Volunteers will also be responsible for using carts on the course to help shuttle players and volunteers

Must be knowledgeable in golf etiquette and able to operate a golf cart

Driving Range: Manage practice ball supply and player ID signs on the practice range

Hospitality: Check credentials, distribute wristbands, and provide general assistance at all hospitality locations

Marshals: Provide crowd control and enforce golf etiquette among spectators (Wednesday – Sunday)

**Must be knowledgeable in golf etiquette, be able to walk to and from assignments, be able to stand for extended periods of time*

Media Center: Assist tournament staff with the general operations of the Media Center. Duties include checking in members of the media, assisting with clipping articles, and other tasks as assigned by the tournament staff

Player Services: Responsible for player registration, as well as the set-up and organization of the locker room

Committee is for women only

Pro-Am Operations: Assist with Pro-Am by driving carts, caddying, and fulfilling various other duties



Scoring Central: Assist in the management of the LPGA's scoring system in scoring trailer (Wednesday – Sunday)

Scoring Tents: Responsible for obtaining players' scorecards on the 9th and 18th scoring tents after player's rounds are complete. "Runners" are responsible for running scores at the completion of each round of the necessary locations

Standard Bearers: Walk 18 holes with group of players while carrying standard (sign) and updating players' scores
Requires the ability to walk 18 holes, and lift and carry 20 pounds

Supply Distribution: Responsible for distribution product such as water, soda, and snacks throughout the course.
Must be knowledgeable in golf etiquette, able to lift heavy objects, and able to operate a golf cart

Television: Assist Golf Channel staff in production of telecast (Thursday-Sunday only, must be able to walk 18 holes and have general knowledge of golf etiquette and scoring)

Transportation: Drive tournament professionals in tournament vehicles to and from select locations (should have knowledge of local roads)
**Must be at least 25 years of age, provide a copy of your valid driver's license, and complete driver information during volunteer registration*

Transportation volunteers may also be needed on the Saturday and Sunday before the tournament and the Monday after

Volunteer Services: Manage uniform distribution; staff volunteer center during Tournament week

Walking Scorers: Walk and record scores for LPGA players with the event's scoring system (Wednesday – Sunday)
