



2022 Gainbridge LPGA at Boca Rio Volunteer Committee Descriptions January 24th – 30th, 2022

The following are brief descriptions of the volunteer committees available for the tournament. Specific openings are not guaranteed, but the tournament will make every effort to accommodate your preferences. Please take a moment to review the following requirements before making your final committee selection.

Age Requirements: Volunteers must be at least 18 years of age as of the first day of tournament week, unless a legal guardian signs the volunteer application/waiver. Volunteers 13 and under **MUST** volunteer with a parent or guardian.

Shifts Required: In general, volunteers are asked to complete a minimum of three (4-6 hour) shifts in order to participate as a volunteer. Most committees will have an a.m. and p.m. shift. **HOWEVER**, some committees are not asked to report until later in the day due to the tournament needs.

Admissions/Will Call

Admissions volunteers are responsible for staffing the ticket booth and assisting security to ensure that all spectators have the proper tickets for entry. Will Call volunteers are responsible for staffing a location for ticket buyers to pick up previously purchased tickets.

Physical Effort: LOW

Active days: Thursday-Sunday of Tournament week. Approximately 7:30am – 5:00pm each day (*outdoor committee*)

Caddie Tent

Caddie Tent volunteers are responsible for assisting the professional caddies throughout the tournament. Volunteers are also responsible for distributing and collecting caddie bibs, towels and lunch vouchers. Other duties include managing the Caddie Tent and caddie registration.

Physical Effort: LOW

Active days: Monday-Sunday of tournament week. Approximately 6:00am – 6:00pm each day (*outdoor committee*)

Carts and Shuttles

Carts and Shuttles Committee volunteers manage the cart area and control the charging, distribution, and collection of carts to authorized personnel. Volunteers will also be responsible for using carts on the course to help shuttle players and volunteers. Must be knowledgeable in golf etiquette and able to operate a golf cart.

Physical Effort: MODERATE - Able to get in and out of a golf cart easily, can sit for long periods of time.

Active days: Monday-Sunday of tournament week. Approximately 6:00am – 6:00pm each day (*outdoor committee*)

Driving Range

Volunteers assist in providing and maintaining a suitable Driving Range for all players. Specific duties include maintaining supplies such as range balls, beverages and player identification signs.

Physical Effort: LOW to MODERATE – Must be able to stand for long periods of time

Active days: Monday-Sunday of tournament week. Approximately 6:00am – 6:00pm each day (*outdoor committee*)

Marshals

Marshals are located throughout the course with a focus on tees, landing areas, greens and spectator crosswalks. Marshals ensure safety of spectators and players and must be knowledgeable in golf etiquette. Committee specific training will be provided prior to the event.

Physical Effort: MODERATE - Must be able to walk to and from assigned hole locations and stand for long periods of time. Marshals are encouraged to bring a small chair to sit during down times.

Active days: Wednesday-Sunday of tournament week. Times vary based on tee times (*outdoor committee*)

Pro-Am Operations

Volunteers assist groups participating in the Pro-Am by driving carts, registration, and fulfilling various other duties. Volunteers must be knowledgeable in golf etiquette.

Physical Effort: MODERATE TO HIGH – Volunteer must be able to operate a golf cart and lift heavy objects.

Active days: Monday and Wednesday of tournament week. Approximately 7:00am – 6:00pm. (*indoor committee*)

Scoring Central

Scoring Central volunteers are responsible for obtaining the scores from Walking Scorers via radio and entering them into the computer for the electronic scoreboard. Computer skills and the capability to use radio are preferred.

Physical Effort: LOW

Active days: Thursday-Sunday of tournament week. Approximately 7:00am – 6:00pm. (*indoor committee*)

Scoring Tents

Volunteers are stationed in the scoring tents behind the 9th and 18th holes and obtain scorecards from the players after they have completed their round. The “Runners” are responsible for running scores at the completion of each round to the necessary locations.

Physical Effort: LOW

Active days: Thursday-Sunday of tournament week. Approximately 10:00am – 6:00pm. (*outdoor committee, covered by a tent*)

Standard Bearers

Standard Bearer responsibilities include carrying a 4' standard (sign) for an entire round and updating the

standard with each player's score after finishing each hole. Volunteers should be at least 13 years old and have a knowledge of golf etiquette.

Physical Effort: HIGH- Must have ability to walk 18 holes while carrying a 5lb standard. A holster is provided to rest the standard in while walking the course.

Active days: Thursday-Sunday of tournament week. Approximately 7:00am – 5:00pm. (*outdoor committee*)

Supply Distribution

Volunteers are responsible for distributing product such as water, soda and snacks throughout the course. Volunteers must be knowledgeable in golf etiquette, able to lift heavy objects, and able to operate a golf cart.

Physical Effort: HIGH – Must be able to lift cases of water, product and other heavy supply items.

Active days: Monday-Sunday of tournament week. 6:00am – 6:00pm. (*outdoor committee*)

Television

Volunteers assist the television network staff in production of the telecast. Substantial golf knowledge is necessary.

Physical Effort: HIGH – Must be able to support TV crew, bending, lifting, standing.

Active days: Thursday-Sunday of Tournament week. Times dependent on TV schedule (*outdoor committee*)

***Volunteers must be available everyday of tournament play (Thursday, January 23rd – Sunday, January 26th)**

Transportation

Volunteers are responsible for transporting players, staff and VIPs to various locations (including hotels, airport and private housing) in courtesy vehicles provided by the Tournament.

*** Must be 25 years of age, provide a copy of your valid driver's license, and complete required driver information during volunteer registration.**

Physical Effort: LOW TO MODERATE - may need to assist with loading items into vans.

Active: Sunday of Advance Week - Monday after tournament week. Times vary (*indoor committee*)

Volunteer Services

Volunteers are responsible for staffing the Volunteer Center, handling uniform distribution, and maintaining a comfortable working environment for the volunteers. Volunteers will also assist to the distribution of lunches to on-course volunteers.

Physical Effort: MODERATE – able to move boxes, bend and sort merchandise.

Active days: Monday-Sunday of tournament week. Approximately 6:00am – 6:00pm (*indoor committee*)

Walking Scorers

Each scorer follows a particular group with a wireless handheld palm and headset, marking each stroke and specific statistics. At the end of each hole, these volunteers are responsible for communicating scores to the central scoring network. Training will be provided, however substantial golf knowledge is necessary.

Physical Effort: HIGH - must have the ability to walk 18 holes unassisted.

Active: Thursday-Sunday of tournament week. Approximately 6:30am – 6:00pm (*outdoor committee*)
